TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY. PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

1. Entry is open to all school-aged students. Door entry is free, but to help defray costs donations are welcome.
2. Entry Fees: Solos \$12; Duos/duets \$12; Ensembles \$24.
3. In each class each entrant is limited to **one piece** or **one movement** from a suite or sonata.
4. For ensemble items, the class is determined by the **highest school year of the student group**.
5. Whilst playing by memory is encouraged, this does not incur additional marks.
6. Students may enter in the Festival **and** Grade 6 and over may also enter for the Recital classes to be held on Saturday 26 September 2020.
7. Each performer will receive a written report.
8. Entrants below Grade 6, strive to achieve a standard (see details on the website).
9. Award placings will only occur in the competition classes. Grade 6 and above.
10. Entrants are expected to dress in concert dress, refer to Performance Pointers on the website.
11. If an accompanist is required, this must be organised by the entrant. A backing accompaniment track (not the solo line) may be used. The entrant must provide any equipment required (other than the piano).
12. For all classes, copies of the music to be performed must be available for the adjudicator on the day of the competition. Photocopies are acceptable for this purpose and should be in excellent condition. Please note that all photocopies will be destroyed after the event.
13. Adjudicator's copies must be clearly labelled with the **Class number, number in the class (in the top right hand corner) and underneath this, the competitor's name**. The teacher's name must not be visible to the adjudicator.
14. Awards shall be at the discretion of the adjudicator whose decision is final.
15. Selected students will be invited to perform at the Showcase Concert on Monday 1 June 2020 at 2pm
16. Special trophies will be presented at the Showcase Concert.
17. Unless advised to the contrary, competitors accept that their name, photograph or video footage may be included in any results published and/or used for publicity.
18. **Closing date for entries is Sunday 17 May**. Enter Online. www.kapimanamusic.org.nz

CLASSES AVAILABLE IN 2020

Solo classes – awards by standard reached (no ranking). See marking criteria.

1. Under Grade 1 (school years 1–5)
2. Grade 1 and above (school years 1–5)
3. Under Grade 3 (school years 6–8)
4. Grade 3 and above (school years 6–8)
5. Under Grade 4 (school years 9–13)
6. Grades 4 & 5. (school years 9–13)

Solo competitive classes (ranked)

7. Piano Solo, Grades 6 & 7
8. String solo, Grades 6 & 7
9. Wind or Brass solo, Grades 6 & 7
10. Piano solo, Grade 8 and above
11. String solo, Grade 8 and above
12. Wind or Brass solo, Grade 8 and above

A dance movement – solo instrument or combination (reach a standard), eg waltz, gavotte, sarabande, minuet, courante, mazurka, tango etc.

13. A dance – any solo instrument or combination (school years 1–5)
14. A dance – any solo instrument or combination (school years 6–8)
15. A dance – any solo instrument or combination (school years 9–13)

Group classes (based on age of eldest entrant) (reach a standard)

16. Duet/duo (school years 1–8)
17. Duet/duo (school years 9–13)
18. Ensemble – three or more (school years 1–8)
19. Ensemble – three or more (school years 9–13) Sunday evening

Special Awards: to be awarded at the Showcase Concert (Monday 1 June, 2pm)

- Most promising Junior musician (school years 1–5) Northern Music Trophy
- Most promising Intermediate musician (school years 6–8) Shona Murray Trophy
